A/C #1. KI-45 Kai Type Tei. 53rd Sentai, 2nd Hikotai, Feb 1945, Matsudo A/B, Chiba Prefecture, Japan. Overall light gray with dark green spots on upper surfaces. All Hinomarus on white home defense bands. White band on rear fuselage. Nose flash is red with white outline. Spinner is red brown with red tip and white outline.

A/C #2. KI-45 Kai Special version 4th Sentai flown by 2nd Lt. Misaburo Yamamoto, leader of the KAITEN-TAI, 1945. Probably based at Ozuki A/B, Yamaguchi Prefecture. Camouflage as above aircraft. Special version of Toryu with all armament removed and rear gunner seat removed and sealed. Used for ramming B29's. Fuselage bands and Sentai emblem is yellow with white outline. All Hinomarus on white bands. 2nd Lt Yamamoto died by ramming a B29 over Fukuoka on April 18, 1945

A/C #3. KI-45 Kai Type Tei 53rd Sentai, 3rd Hikohtai, Feb 1945 Matsudo A/B, Chiba Prefecture, Japan. Overall Kawasaki (aprox FS34096) dark olive. All Hinomarus on white bands. Rear fuselage band is white.

A/C #4. KI-45 Kai special version of 53rd Sentai, 3rd Shinten-Seikentai, 1945 Matsudo AB, Chiba Prefecture, Japan. Overall light gray with dark green spots on upper surfaces. All Hinomarus on white bands. Spinner red brown with white tip.
