FJ-4B Fury (1962 Redesignation: AF-1E) Made by North American Aviation Inc. A US Navy carrier-based jet fighter, used more for attack than interception. This "B" version had 6 underwing pylons and could carry 5 Bullpup missiles or 6 Sidewinders, other under wing stores were bombs, air to surface rockets or four 200



gallon (757 litres) drop tanks. Powered by uprated Wright built J65 Sapphire engine producing 7700 lbs (3493kg) thrust.

First flight December 1956. Total production — 222 examples
