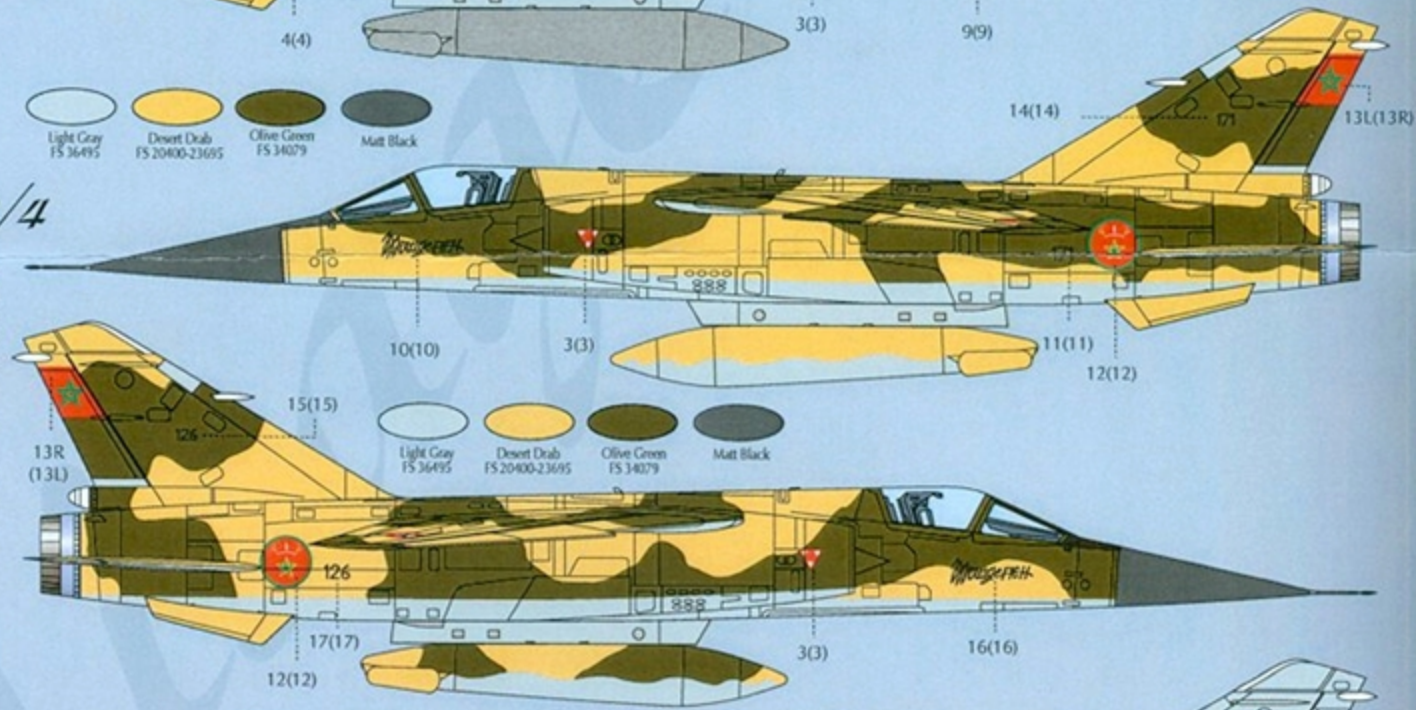
Aircraft 1/2

Mirage F-1EQ4 of the Iraqi Air Force. These two a/c took part on the Iran-Iraq war and claimed over 35 kills, including a Tomcat F-14. They were all painted Sand and Dark Brown over Light Gray, very similar to the French Desert Camo. (Possibly the same colors.) Years later, these a/c suffered heavily during the Coalition airfield attacks and many were destroyed in the air by USAF F-15's. Several dozens of them took refuge in Iran hoping they would be returned after the hostilities ceased. Final disposition is unknown.



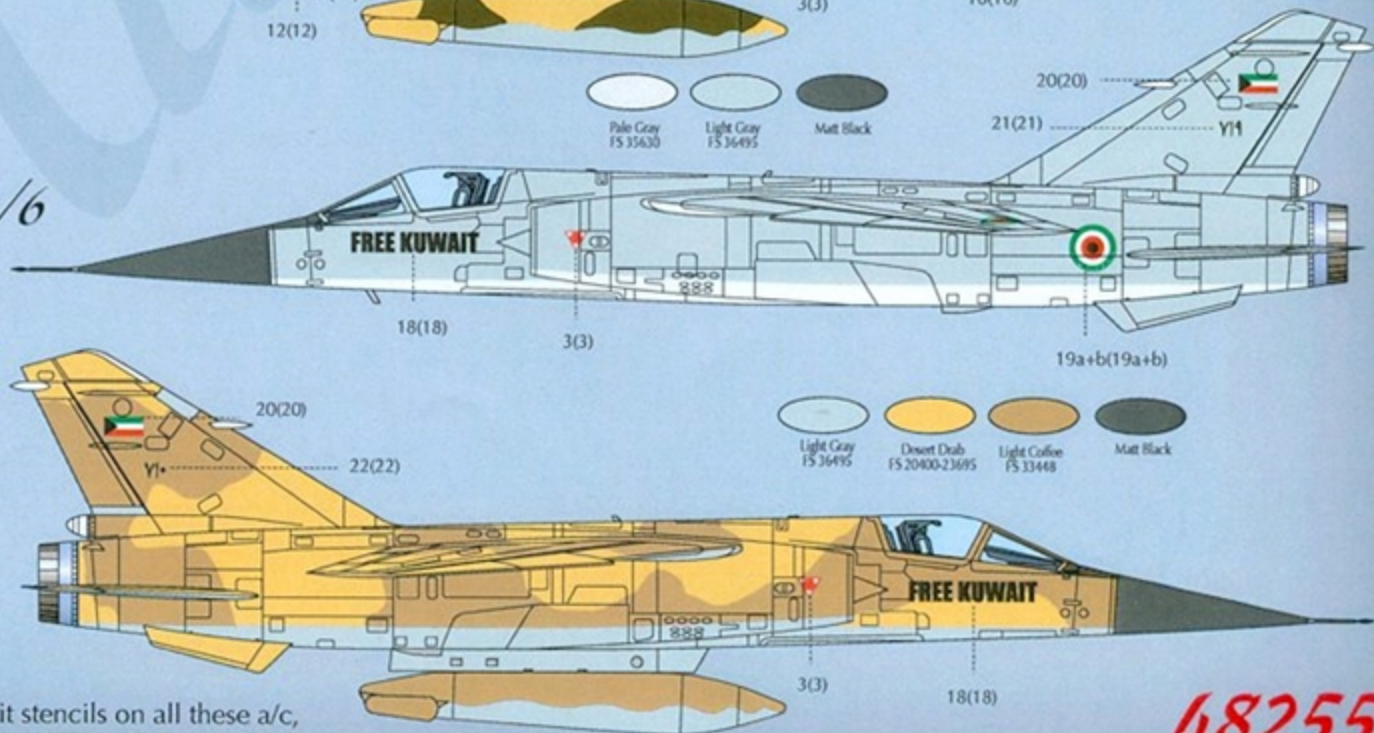
Aircraft 3/4

Mirage F-1EH and CH of the Moroccan Air Force. Most of these Mirages were kept in hardened shelters at Sidi Slimane from where detachments were sent to El Aouine for combat operations against Polisario Guerrillas. Three of these a/c were lost to ground fire. They wore a Sand and Olive Green over Light Gray color scheme.




Aircraft 5/6

Mirage F-1CK, Kuwaiti Air Force. Many of these a/c took part in a few clashes against the Iraqi prior to the Invasion losing over eight machines. Some flew with a scheme of Light Gray over a Lighter Gray while others had a Sand and Pale Earth or Coffee color over Light Gray. The Free Kuwait sign was used while in exile in Saudi Arabia.

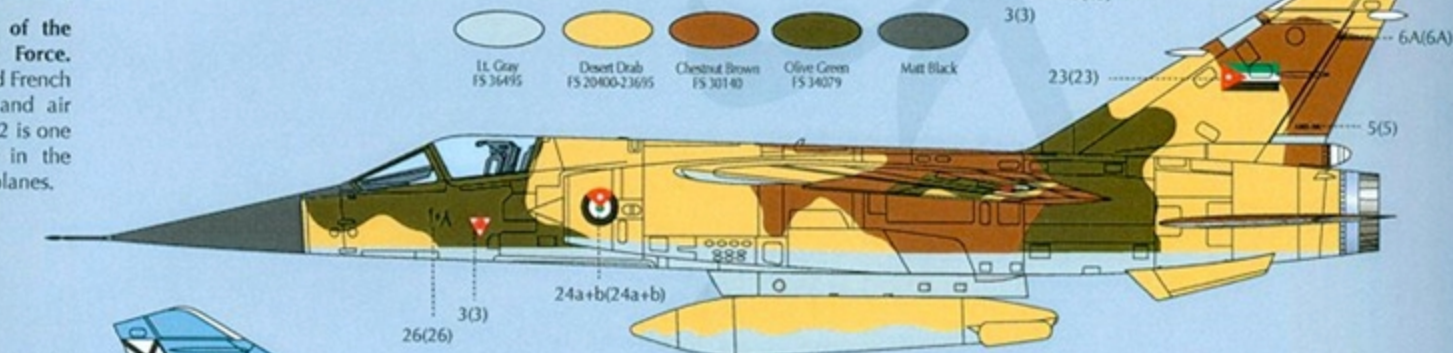
 Aircraft 7/8


Mirage F-1CJ and EJ of the Royal Jordanian Air Force. These a/c wore standard French Desert camo. schemes and air superiority colors. A/C 2 is one of those that arrived in the second batch of 17 airplanes.



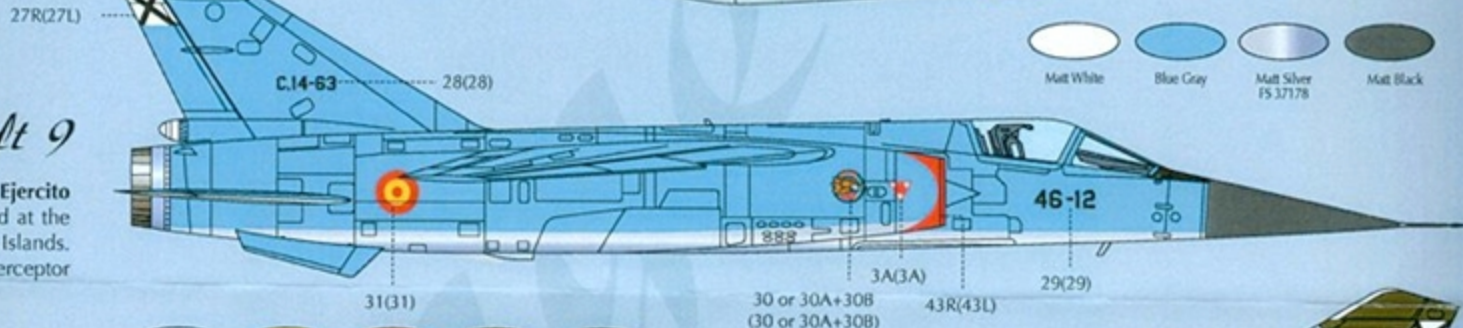


Mirage F-1EE of the Ejercito del Aire, 462 Sq. Based at the Las Palmas AB, Canary Islands. Standard French interceptor camouflage scheme.



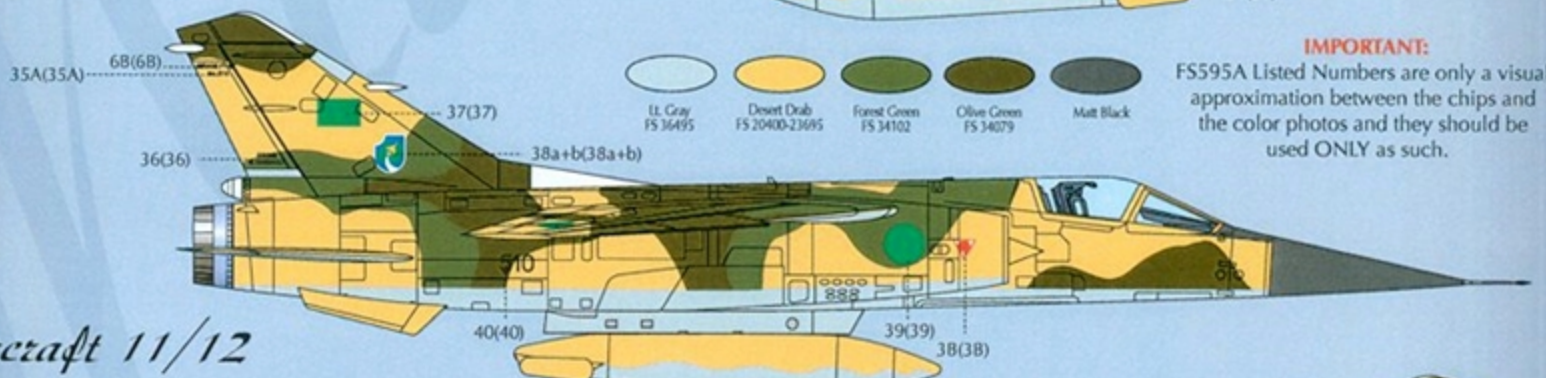
 Aircraft 10

Mirage F-1CE. Although dressed in a tactical scheme, this group of a/c were assigned an Air Defense role during the 70's.



 Aircraft 11/12

Mirage F1-ED and AD of the Libyan Air Force. They were used in raids into Chad and in aggressive moves against the US Fleet during the 80's. Libya was one of the two customers to order the AD radarless model of the F-1. Sand, Forest Green and Olive Green over light Gray was the camouflage worn by these a/c.
