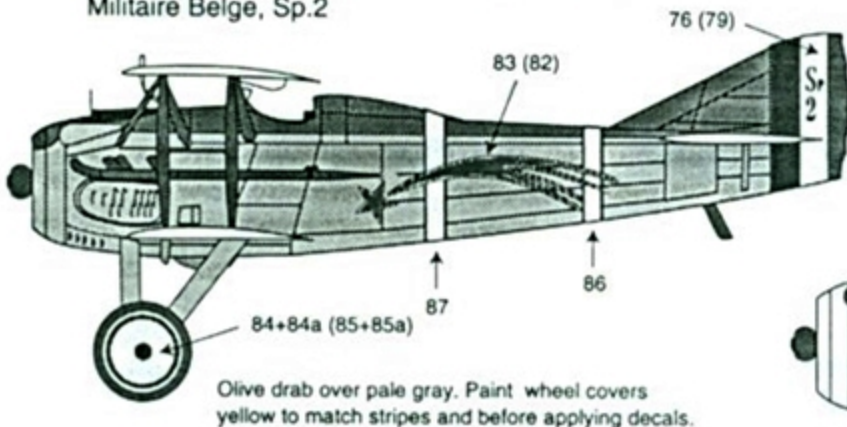
A/C #5 - SPAD 13 of 94th Aero Sq. USAS (Rickenbacker)



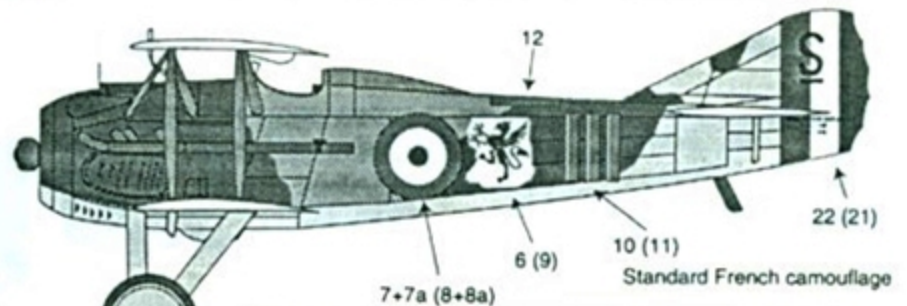
A/C #6 - SPAD 7 of Escadrille Spa. 99



A/C #7 - SPAD 7 of 10th Escadrille, Aviation Militaire Belge, Sp.2

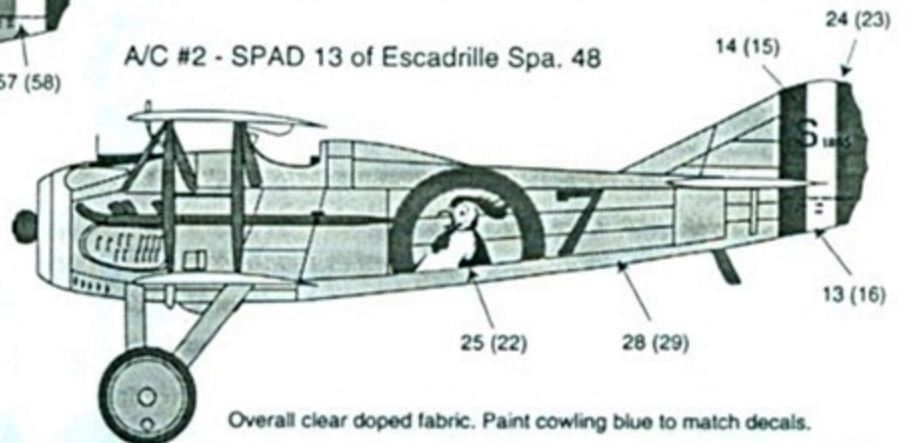


A/C #1 - SPAD 13 of 91e Sq. IAS, Trieste, Italy, August 1918

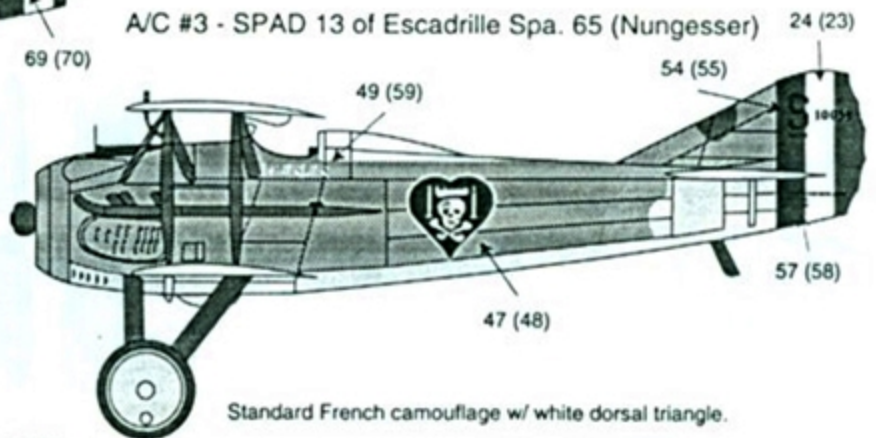

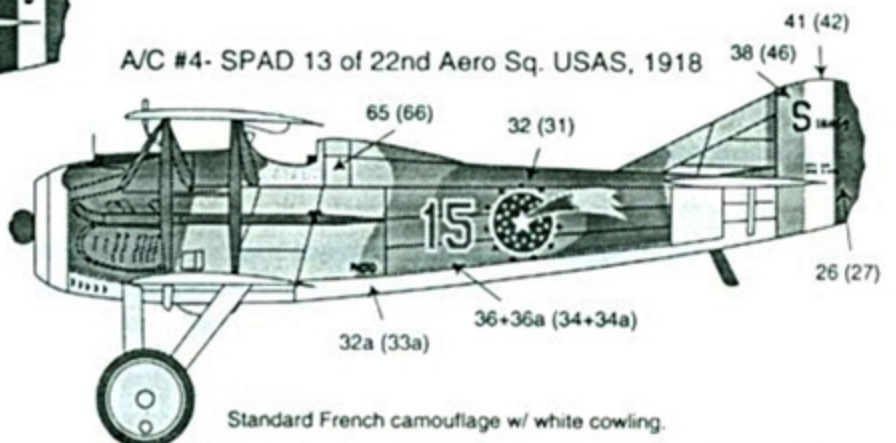
A/C #2 - SPAD 13 of Escadrille Spa. 48



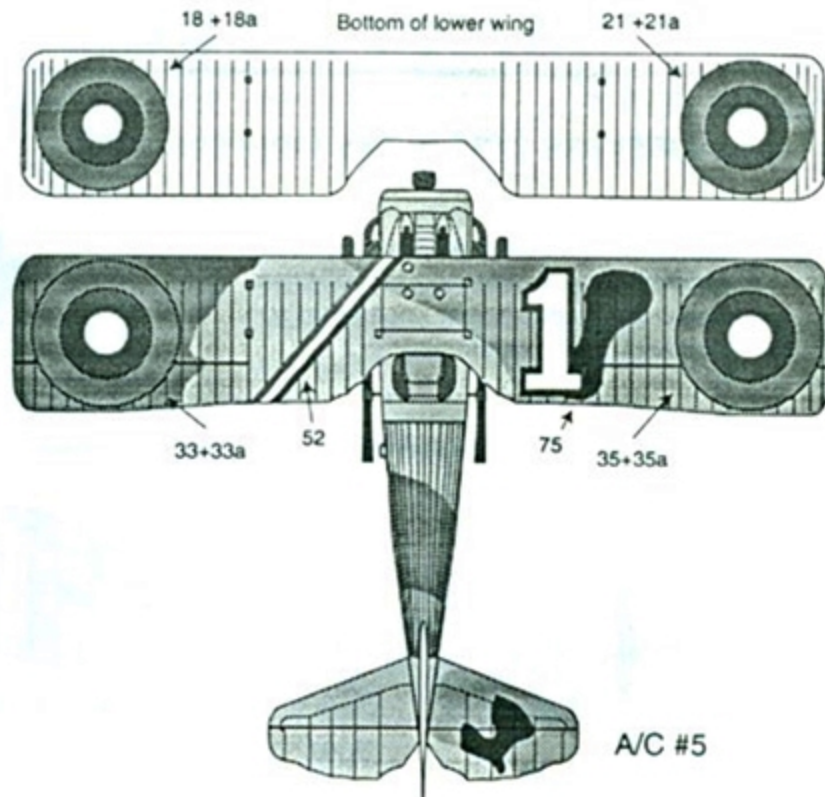
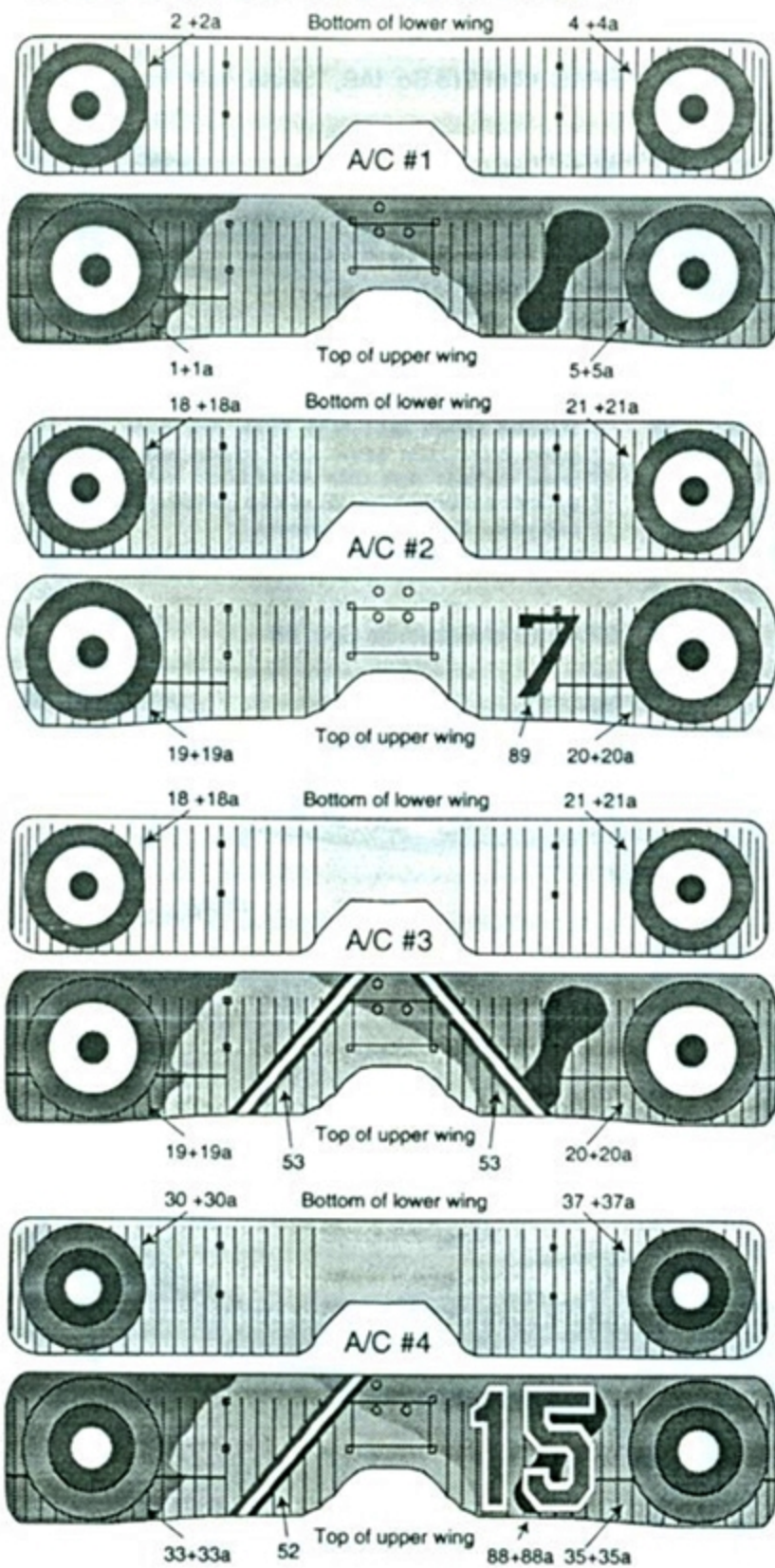
A/C #3 - SPAD 13 of Escadrille Spa. 65 (Nungesser)
