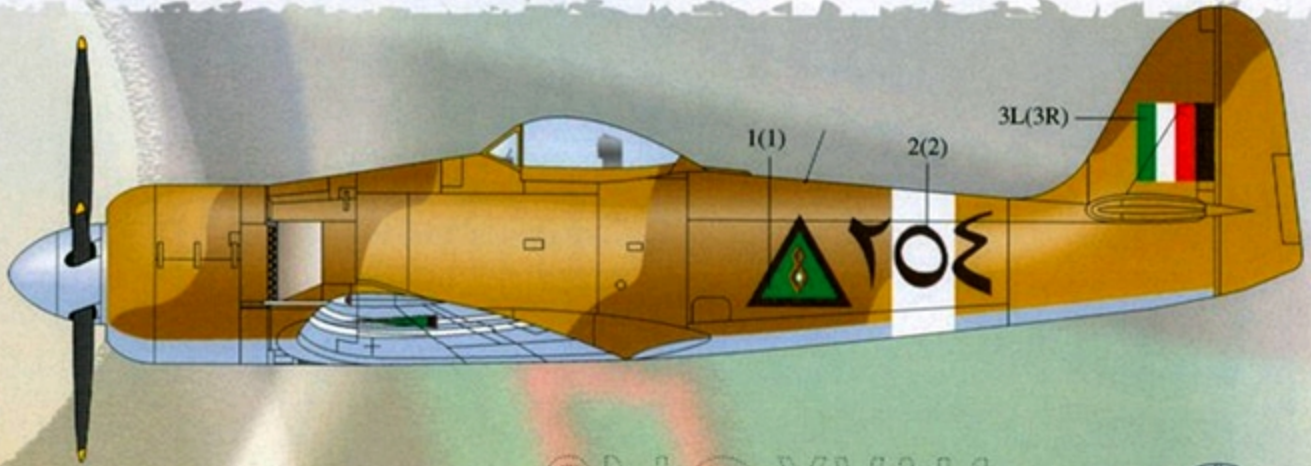

SEA FURY Pt. III



Suggested Kit: Hobbycraft Hawker Seafury.

Sea Fury Mk. 60 (Baghdad Fury), No.254, Royal Iraqi Air Force, mid 1950s. British camouflage scheme of Dark Earth and Mid Stone, with Azure Blue lower surfaces and spinner. Note lack of tail hook and extended rudder unique to the Mk. 60.



Hawker Sea Fury FB 11 WG578, 871 Squadron, RCN, 1953. RCN Dark Sea Grey (Extra Dark Sea Grey) and RCN Light Sea Grey (Medium Sea Grey) camouflage with red spinner.



Wing and fuselage dands on the Baghdad Furies seem to be approximately 18 inches wide.(3/8 inch).
Wing and fuselage bands on Royal Navy Sea Furies (Korean ID bands) were 12 inches wide (1/4 inch).
