The Embraer EMB 110 Bandeirante is a Brazilian twin-turboprop light transport aircraft designed by Embraer for military and civil use. The EMB 110 was designed by the French engineer Max Holste; it had been designed in line with specifications issued by the Brazilian Ministry of Aeronautics in 1965. Various customers in both the military and civilian sectors opted to procure the EMB 110 during its 22-year production run. As a result, production of the EMB 110 was terminated during 1990.

The model is executed on technology short run and is intended only for experienced modelers
