


## **IMPORTANT! READ THESE POINTS BEFORE YOU BEGIN**





Cement parts. Use cement made for styrene plastic only.




Do not cement together.

Paint all sub-assemblies before attaching parts. Use only bottle or spray paint made for styrene plastic. Scrape paint & chrome away from surfaces to be cemented together.




This kit may be built more than one way. Decide on which version you wish to build.



- White numbers in a star indicate an assembly.
- Black numbers in a star indicate a completed assembly.
- Black numbers in a circle indicate part numbers.




Apply decal at this time. Cut decal from sheet. Place decal in warm water for about 45 seconds, then slide decal off backing paper into position and wipe decal gently with a damp cloth.





## PAINT SUGGESTIONS:


