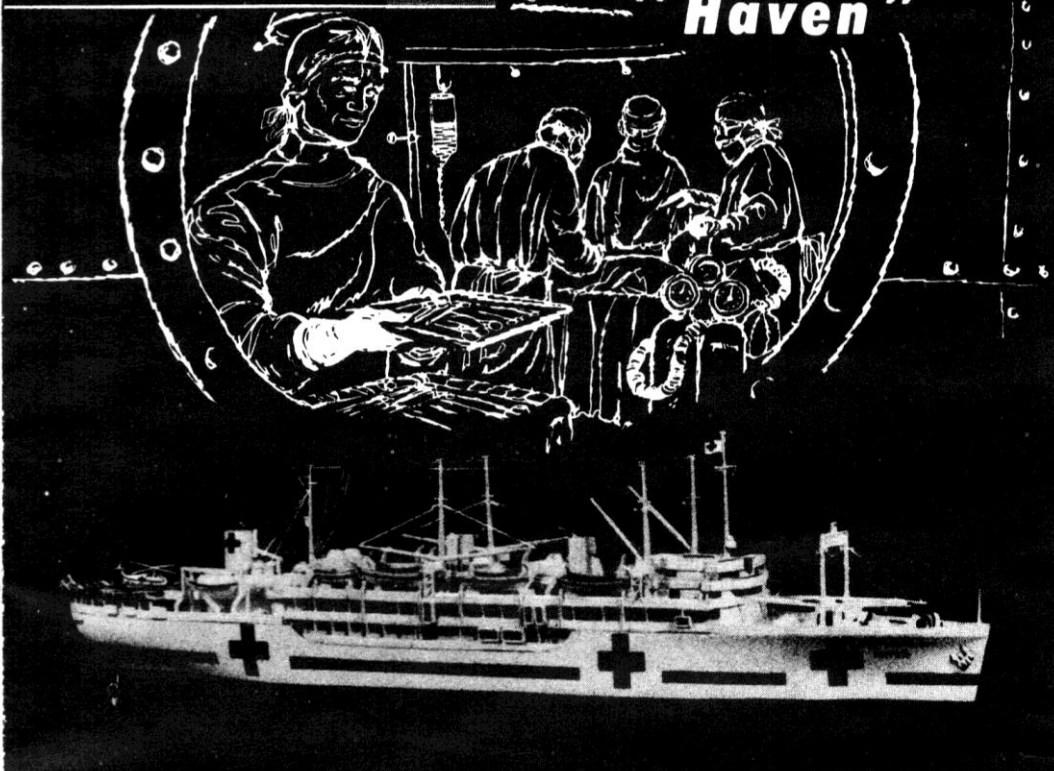

KIT 0320 INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT YOUR HOSPITAL SHIP "HAVEN" 0320R4200

The Hospital Ship Haven was the first of a series of six ships that were designed specifically for this purpose. Prior to this it was the practice to convert regular vessels to fulfill this function. These ships represent the culmination of years of experience and an almost solid year of planning.

No description of these new ships can do justice to the ingenuity and concern for detail that went into the planning. The ships were designed as "floating hospitals," and therefore, their capacity exceeds that of any other Navy hospital ship by several hundred beds. Permanent wards allow for 802 patients, 742 enlisted men and 60 officers. These facilities can be expanded to handle 1,000 cases, if the need arises. A complete surgical suite, located on the second deck, and at the center of the ship where the roll is at a minimum, is as complete as any land based hospital.

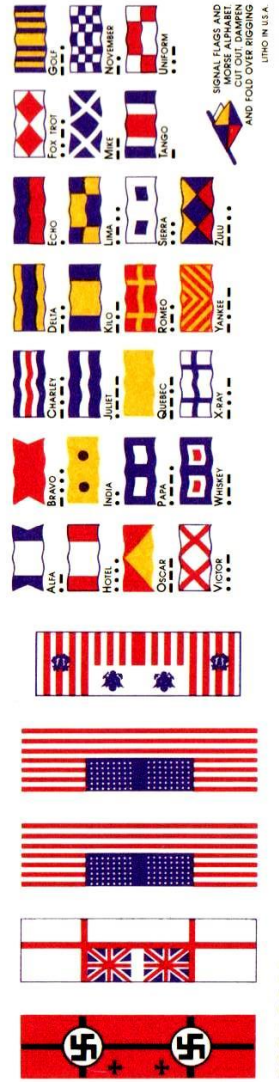
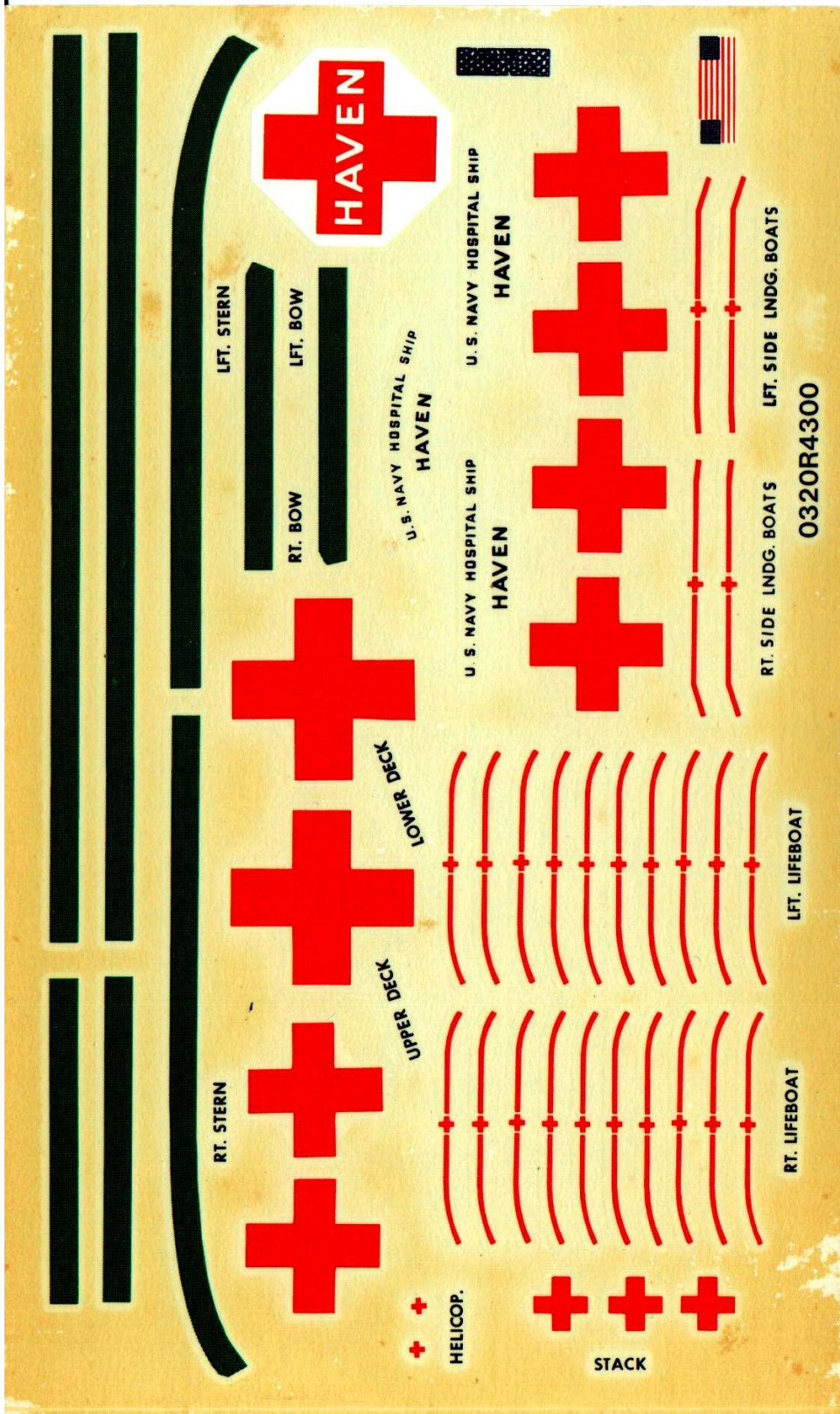
Also incorporated aboard are many recreational facilities, and a mammoth ice cream making machine. There is room for motion pictures, and the ship is equipped with a complete library. Adequate space for deck chairs is provided for the sun bathing of recovering patients, while a large lounge below can be used in the evenings.

The HAVEN displaces 15,000 tons, has seven decks and an overall length of 520 feet. The beam is 71 feet 6 inches, and at a speed of 17½ knots, she has a cruising radius of 12,000 miles.


The HAVEN and several other ships of this class performed heroic services in the recent Korean War, where they served the forces of the United Nations.

Original Sheet is double sided 11" X 17" format. Title and Catalog advertisement are on one side, four construction steps on reverse.

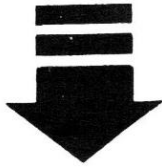
Decal and Flag Sheets



NOTE: Apply cement sparingly, since it will soften plastic if too much is used. Do not let cement touch the eyes or your clothing.

Read Instruction Sheet over carefully before starting to build your model. This Kit is molded of Styrene Plastic. Be sure to use only Revell Type  Cement for best results. Ask for it by name. Before assembling kit, trim all excess plastic from parts for a good fit. Parts are numbered to simplify your assembly.

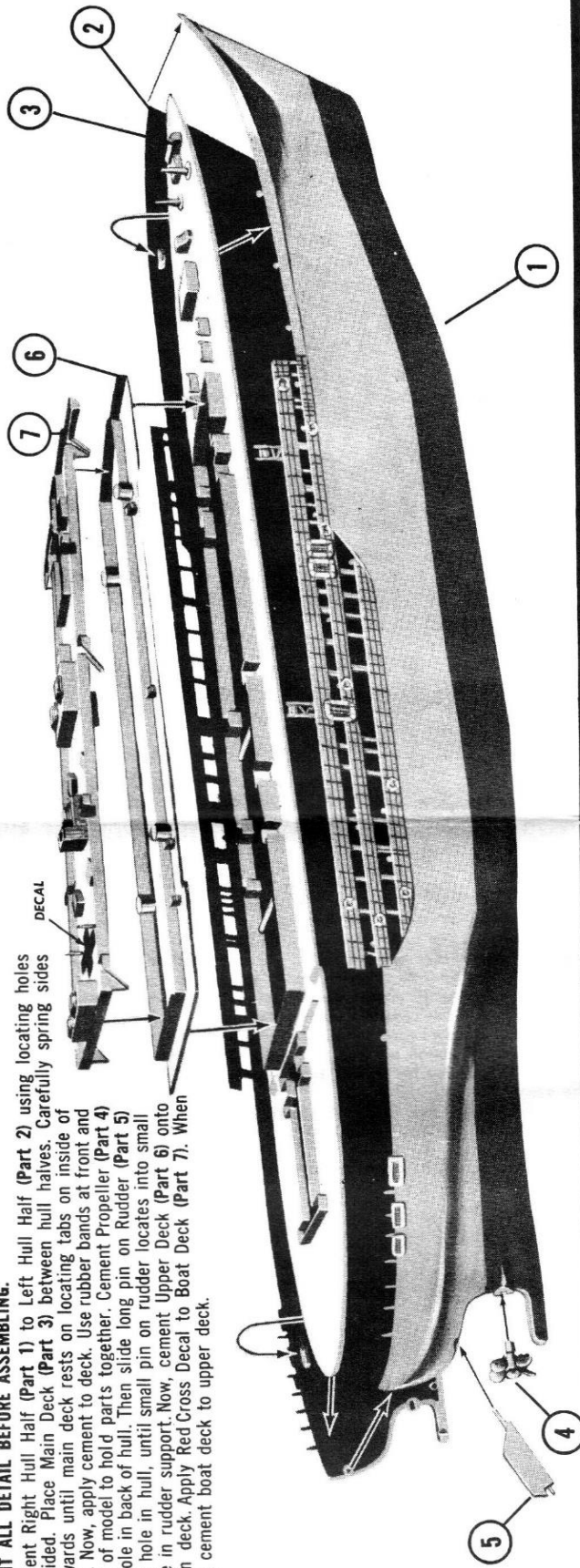
THIS IS IMPORTANT: Paint all parts before assembling. Use Revell Paint Set Enamel Colors. Be sure all parts are dry before cementing. We suggest you use masking tape as a guide for painting hull, or any other parts, where needed. Use rubber bands to hold hull halves together. Read back of Decal Sheet carefully before applying decals. If you wish to add rigging and flags, follow illustration below.

FOR EASE IN BUILDING YOUR MODEL**

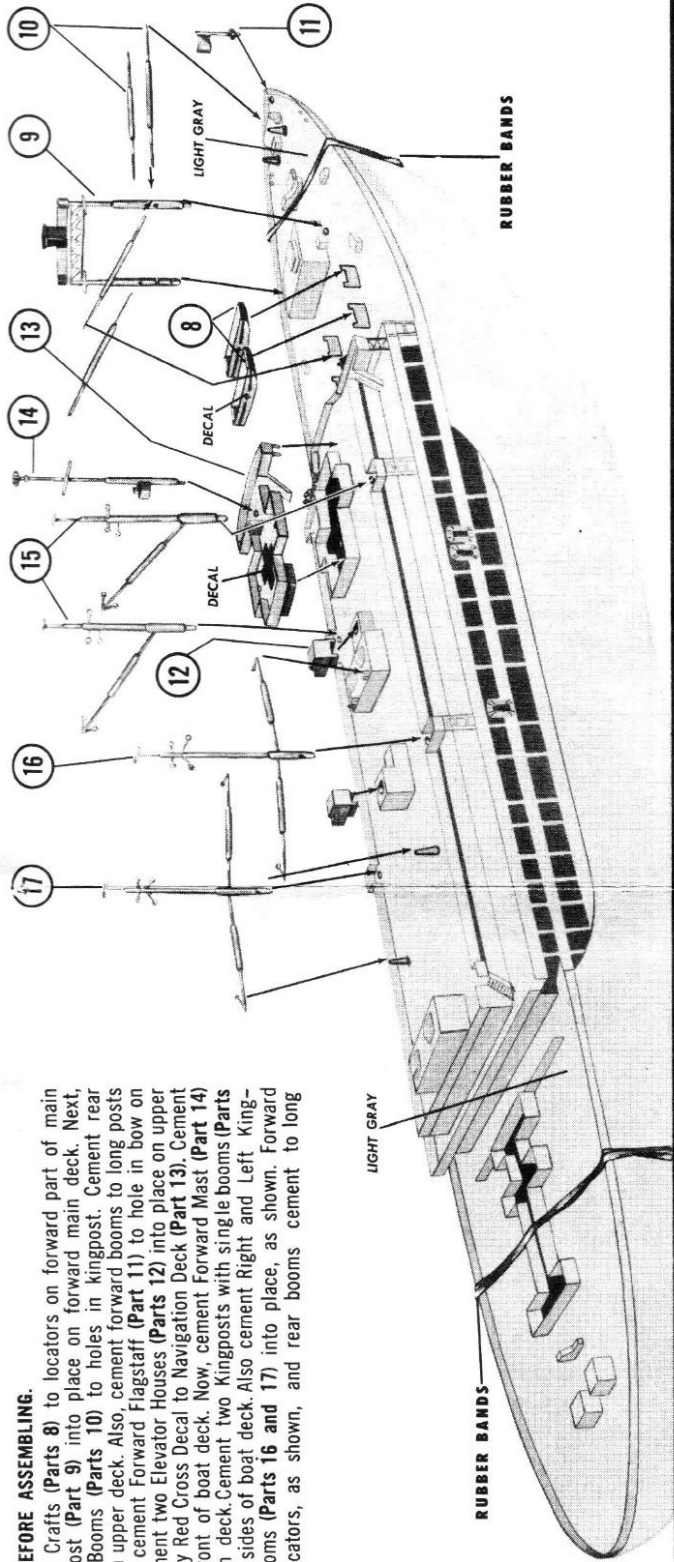
PAINT ALL DETAIL BEFORE ASSEMBLING.

Cement Right Hull Half (Part 1) to Left Hull Half (Part 2) using locating holes provided. Place Main Deck (Part 3) between hull halves. Carefully spring sides outwards until main deck rests on locating tabs on inside of hull. Now, apply cement to deck. Use rubber bands at front and rear of model to hold parts together. Cement Propeller (Part 4) to hole in back of hull. Then slide long pin on Rudder (Part 5) into hole in hull, until small pin on rudder locates into small hole in rudder support. Now, cement Upper Deck (Part 6) onto main deck. Apply Red Cross Decal to Boat Deck (Part 7). When dry, cement boat deck to upper deck.



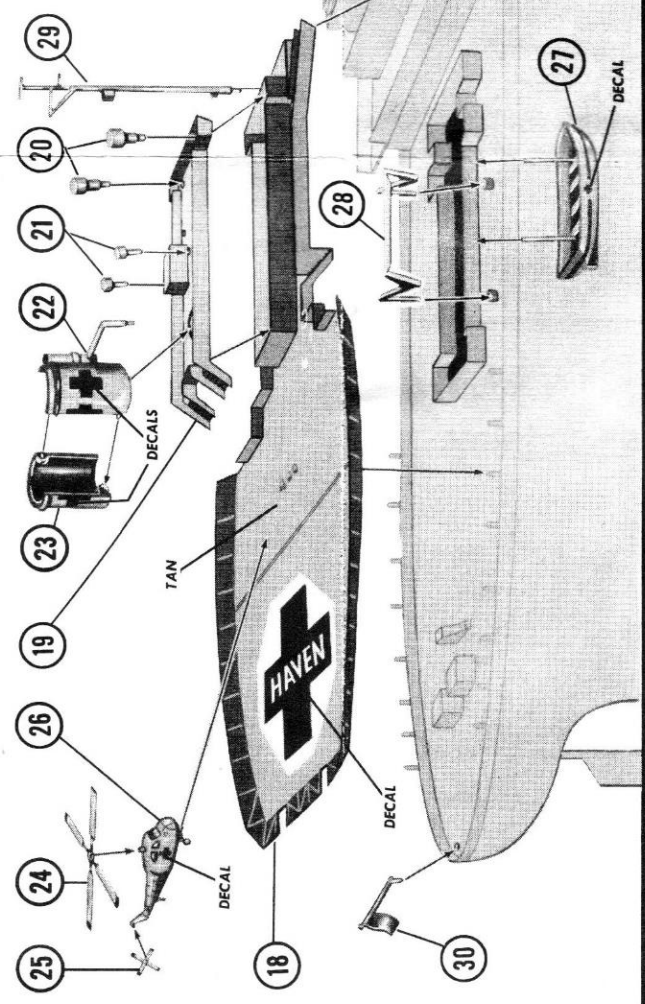
PAINT ALL DETAIL BEFORE ASSEMBLING.

Cement two Landing Crafts (Parts 8) to locators on forward part of main deck. Cement Kingpost (Part 9) into place on forward main deck. Next, cement four Small Booms (Parts 10) to holes in kingpost. Cement rear booms to locators on upper deck. Also, cement forward booms to long posts on main deck. Now, cement Forward Flagstaff (Part 11) to hole in bow on main deck. Next, cement two Elevator Houses (Parts 12) into place on upper deck, as shown. Apply Red Cross Decal to Navigation Deck (Part 13). Cement navigation deck to front of boat deck. Now, cement Forward Mast (Part 14) to hole in navigation deck. Cement two Kingposts with single booms (Parts 15) to right and left sides of boat deck. Also cement Right and Left Kingposts with twin Booms (Parts 16 and 17) into place, as shown. Forward booms cement to locators, as shown, and rear booms cement to long posts on boat deck.

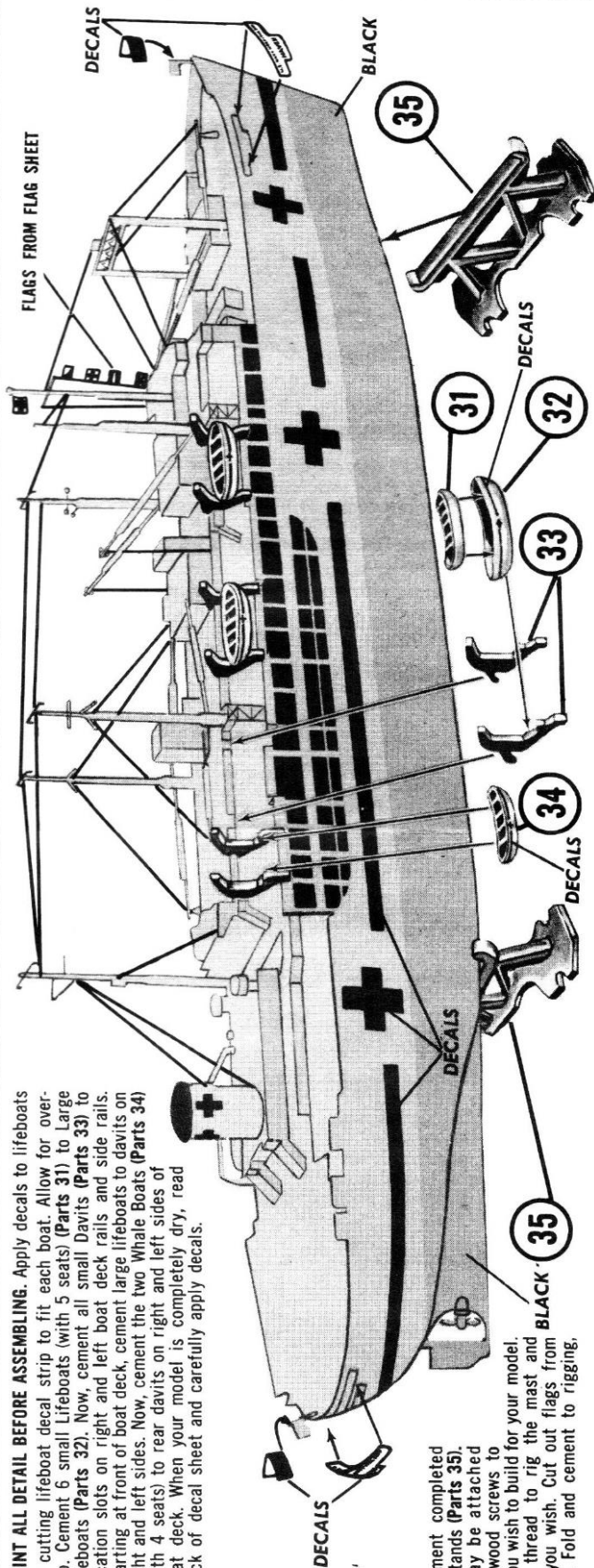


PAINT ALL DETAIL BEFORE ASSEMBLING.

Apply Haven Decal to Helicopter Landing Platform (Part 18). Now, cement helicopter landing platform to rear main deck. Next, cement Engine Housing (Part 19) to Part 18. Next, cement Large Vents (Parts 20) and Small Vents (Parts 21) to holes in engine housing, as shown. Cement Right and Left Stack Halves (Parts 22 and 23) together. Cement completed stack to locator on engine housing, as shown. Small pin on stack locates into small hole in deck. Cement Large and Small Rotor Blades (Parts 24 and 25) to Helicopter (Part 26). Cement Helicopter to outside of decal area on landing platform. (Do not apply cement to decal or it will wrinkle up). Next, cement the long pins on two Motor Launches (Parts 27) into holes in two Large Davits (Parts 28). Now, cement davits to holes on right and left sides of rear main deck so launches are outside of hull. Finally, cement Rear Mast (Part 29) and Rear Flagstaff (Part 30) into place, as shown.

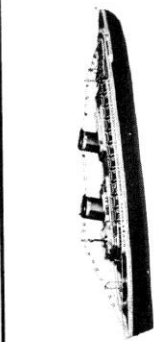


PAINT ALL DETAIL BEFORE ASSEMBLING. Apply decals to lifeboats by cutting lifeboat decal strip to fit each boat. Allow for overlap. Cement 6 small Lifeboats (with 5 seats) (Parts 31) to Large Lifeboats (Parts 32). Now, cement all small Davits (Parts 33) to location slots on right and left boat deck rails and side rails. Starting at front of boat deck, cement large lifeboats to davits on right and left sides. Now, cement the two Whale Boats (Parts 34) (with 4 seats) to rear davits on right and left sides of boat deck. When your model is completely dry, read back of decal sheet and carefully apply decals.



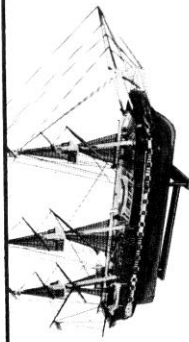
Finally, cement completed model to Stands (Parts 35). Stands may be attached first with wood screws to any base you wish to build for your model. Use black thread to rig the mast and booms if you wish. Cut out flags from flag sheet. Fold and cement to rigging, as shown.

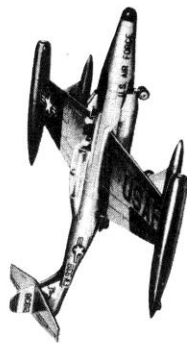
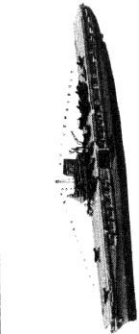
PRIDE OF THE HIGH SEAS

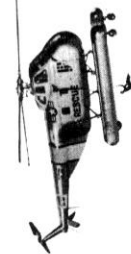
THEY FLY FOR FREEDOM

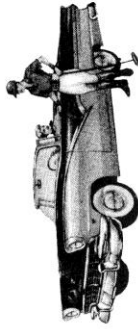
